Status and challenges

- EU financing is available
- Widespread engagement from local heating companies to go green
- New heat strategy expected in conjunction with NECP
- Extensive collaboration between DEA and relevant partners.
- Coming revision of tariff regulation

- Lack of standardized project assessment tools
- Need for coordinated heat planning
- Need better understanding of the roadmap and process of going green
- Need for better understanding of new business cases in decentralized DH
- Value of sector coupling is not broadly understood
